Don't Let a LITTLE DETOUR

Keep You Away From All the Fun!!



Half a mile of **NC Highway 133 (River Road)** heading south towards Winnabow and Brunswick Town/Ft. Anderson—the site of the 2025 NC Rice Festival—will be closed until August 2025 due to major bridge construction. We recommend that Festival-goers take the following detour routes to ensure smooth and safe travel to and from the Festival site.

FOR DRIVERS TRAVELING FROM WILMINGTON WEST OR POINTS/STATES NORTH OF THE FESTIVAL SITE, your best and quickest route is avoid the Hwy 133 construction altogether!

- Take Hwy 17 (Ocean Highway) heading south toward Brunswick County Beaches
- TURN LEFT onto Hwy 87-South/George II Hwy SE
- Drive towards and through the Town of Boiling Spring Lakes
- Drive past the golf course and coffee shop on your left to TURN LEFT onto Fifty Lakes Drive
- Follow that road until it intersects with Hwy 133 and a gas station on your right,
- TURN LEFT onto Hwy 133
- Ignore the road closure signs, the road'll get you there!
- TURN RIGHT when you see the sign for Brunswick Town/Fort Anderson and follow the windy road to the Festival site and free parking

FOR DRIVERS TRAVELING FROM WILMINGTON EAST, CAROLINA BEACH, KURE BEACH, we recommend you take the Ft. Fisher/Bald Head Island Ferry to Southport and avoid most of the traffic and drive time to the Festival site. - Take Hwy 211-North to Hwy 87-North
- TURN RIGHT onto Hwy 133
- Again, ignore the road closure signs, the road'll get you there!
- TURN RIGHT when you see the sign for Brunswick Town/Fort Anderson and follow the windy road to the Festival site and free parking

FOR DRIVERS TRAVELING FROM POINTS/STATES SOUTH OF THE FESTIVAL SITE ...

- Take Hwy 17 (Ocean Highway) heading north toward Wilmington
- TURN RIGHT onto Hwy 87-South/George II Hwy SE
- Drive towards and through the Town of Boiling Spring Lakes
- Drive past the golf course and coffee shop on your left to TURN LEFT onto Fifty Lakes Drive
- Follow that road until it intersects with Hwy 133 (you'll see a gas station on your right)
- TURN LEFT onto Hwy 133
- Ignore the road closure signs, the road'll get you there!
- TURN RIGHT when you see the sign for Brunswick Town/Fort Anderson and follow the windy road to the Festival site and free parking
